Pupil Conferencing

Our Creative Curriculum

Terms 1 and 2 - Ancient Influences (Greeks) and Romans) Roman assembly and trip to Caerleon Terms 3 and 4 - Earth Explorers Volcanoes, mountains, earthquakes, the structure of the earth and field skills. Term 5 and 6 - Our World, Our Future Biodiversity and environmental issues locally and around the world.

Homework

- Reading (min. 3 times a week for at least 15 minutes with an adult) Children will earn team points for their reads with an adult so please sign or write comments to let us know how they have enjoyed the books and any new words they have learned.
- Spelling- Children will write at least 6 words they have found difficult to spell from our lessons. Each unit lasts approximately 2 weeks. We will put examples of the spelling rule in our Teams class announcements if the log book has been forgotten.
- Times tables A weekly task is given on Friday. This is likely to be online via TT Rock Stars. If you have any problems with online access, let us know. Times tables should be practiced several times a week to build resilience and pace.
- Topic talks in terms 3 and 4.
- Occasional topic-related research.
- We always love children to share any work they have completed at home inspired by what they have been learning in school.

Spelling in Year 4

• Children will record their spelling words in their blue log books which they need to regularly practise at home. Most units will last 2 weeks.

• Children will be tested on their words in class. The current spelling pattern will be shown on the class pages in Teams as part of our weekly update.

• There is a list of the Year 3 and 4 orange words in the back of the spelling log to practise at home. We select 8 each term to focus on, and we will put these in the English files in Teams.



The Multiplication Tables Check



Try <u>www.timestables.me.uk</u> for a free online tables test. You can choose the tables to practise and the number of questions to answer. The multiplication tables check is a statutory assessment for primary schools from this year.

The purpose is to determine if pupils can fluently recall their tables up to 12 by the end of Y4.

It is an on-screen assessment carried out on an Ipad consisting of 25 questions. Children have 6 seconds to answer each question. The test lasts approximately 5 minutes.

Children will be able to practise the test in school beforehand. Regular practise of times tables at home help build pace and confidence.
