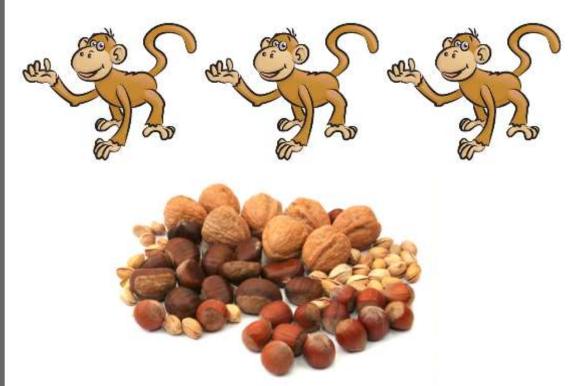

- Have a system for finding the possibilities eg start with the smallest number, know when all possibilities are found, check for repeats of possibilities
