Sonia Delauney

Sonia was born in 1885 in Ukraine but spent most of her life in Paris.

She is very famous for painting, but also for designing clothing, furniture, and even cars! She designed them using something called **geometric abstraction**.

Geometry is all about lines, shapes and angles. Think of some basic shapes - squares, triangles, circles, rectangles. Some artists use these shapes to build, draw and design their artwork.

Abstraction is when you create art that is not focused on making something look real. It is all about lines and shapes and colours.



Sonia Delauney's work uses lots of circles and bold colours.

Can you create a colourful piece of art,
using lots of circles ?

Now your turn

You will need

- A piece of paper, pencil or pen,
- Coloured pencils, felt pens, pastels or paints.

- A collection of objects with circular bases, to draw around
eg cup, jar, can, toilet roll etc

Draw around the bases of your objects in different places on the paper. Some can overlap... Keep going until you are happy with your design.

Finally add colour using whatever you have at home.
